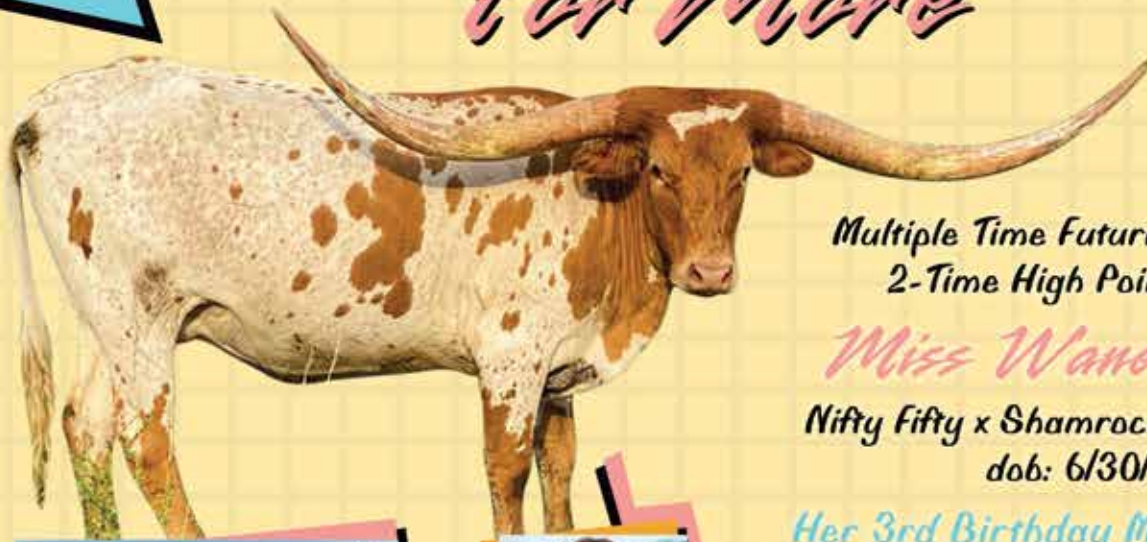

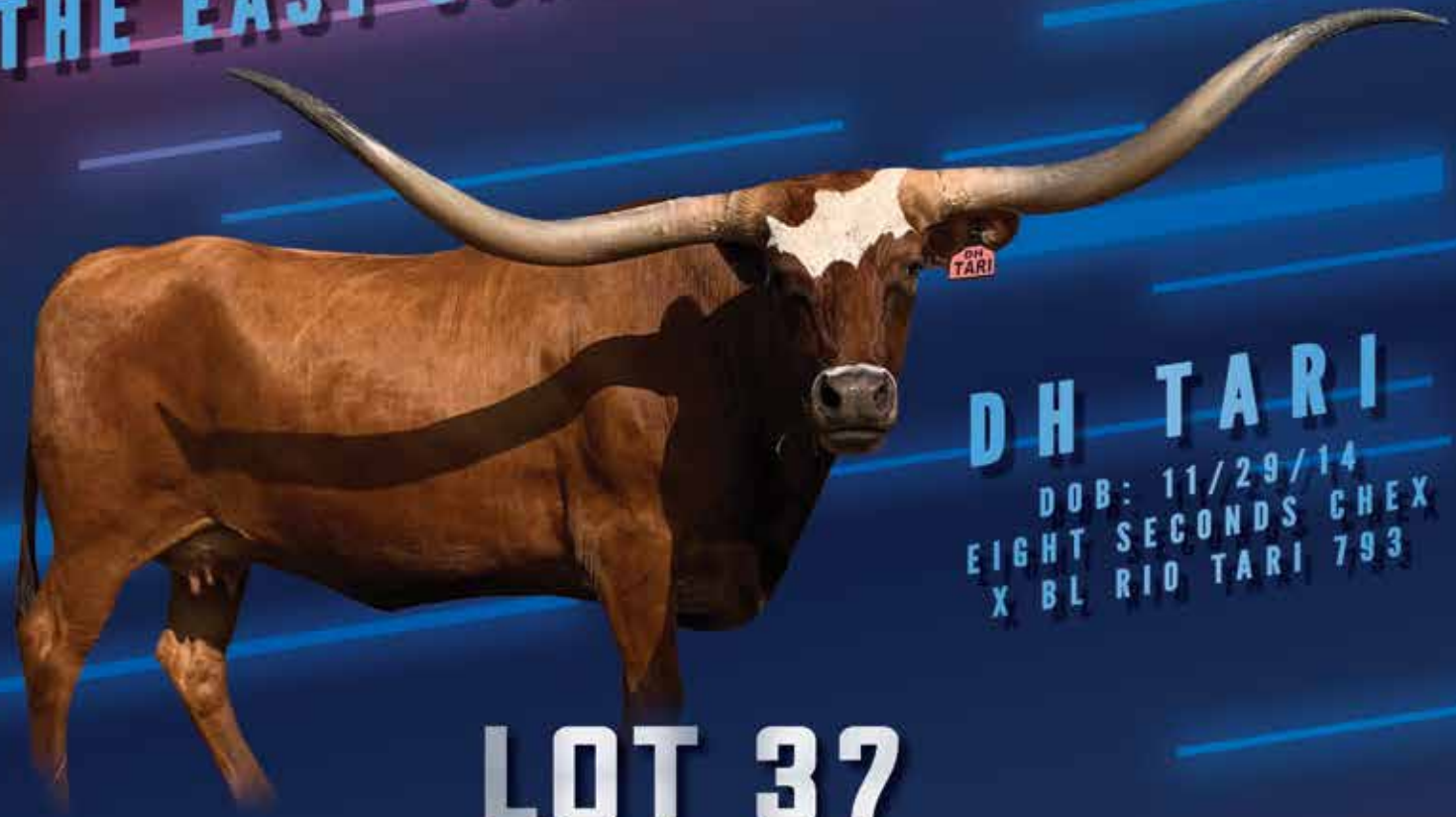

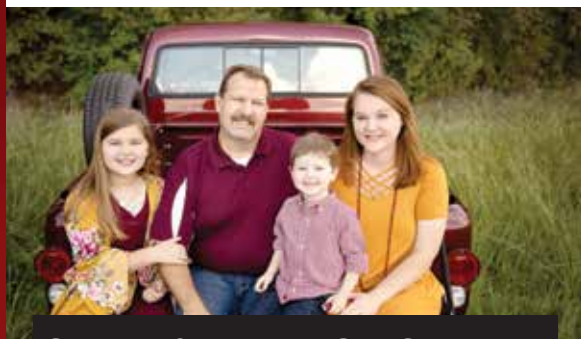

*My most valuable has got to be the Kubota MX110 Tractor with Front End Loader.*



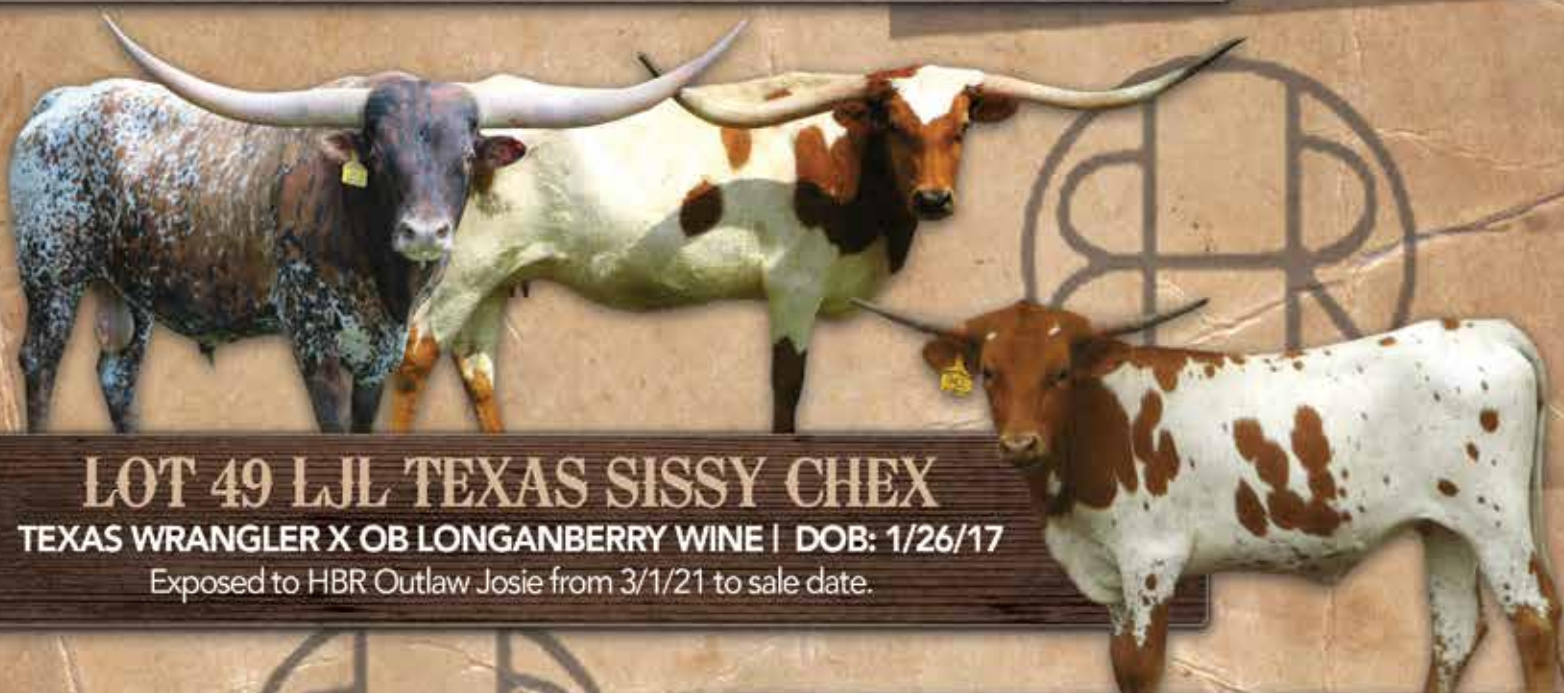

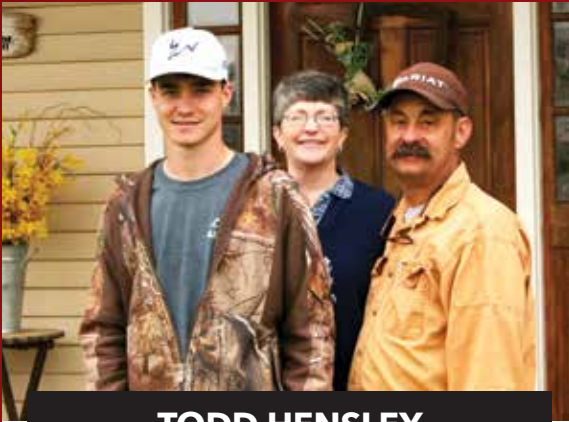

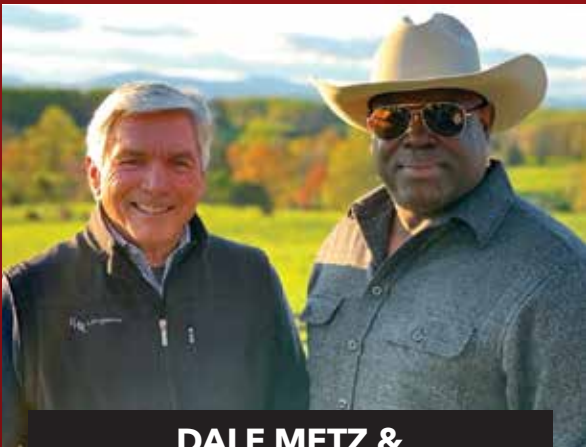

A true breeder has to have patience in order to see the outcome. So many people get discouraged too quickly and give up. It takes time and effort to get to the place you want to be. If you rush through it you will miss the joy of the process and jack things up. If you try to chase the fame you will never catch up. It is a slow process that requires patience and then you will reap the rewards.*
